Bring the following with you for your appointment:

- Proof of Income (check stubs, W-2 forms)
- Current Medicaid Card(s)
- Yourself and your child(ren)
- ID for all (Driver's License, Birth Certificate and/or Social Security Card)
- Immunization record for each child
- If pregnant, a note signed by your doctor stating you are pregnant and your due date
- Proof of address.
