Requirements

- ✓ Be a practicing medical professional and provide proof of license to practice
- ✓ Be currently enrolled in an accredited college, university or technical school
- ✓ Serve as a volunteer for medical roles

Non-medical volunteers are needed, too:

- Registration
- Parking, Traffic, and Crowd Management
- Administrative and Essential Support Services

Requirements

- ✓ Be willing to serve all communities in Seneca County
- ✓ Serve as a volunteer for non-medical roles
- ✓ Participate in trainings such as first-aid, CPR, triage, etc.
